World Championships and World Cup anticipate the Ixs Downhill Cup stage in Pila (Vd'A)

Frantic period for the 'riders' of fat wheels, engaged in these days in the World Championships, in Les Gets (France); then, the transfer to Val di Sole (Trentino) for the stage of the World Cup, from 2 to 4 September. Viaticum of the highest level and, subsequently, direct bow towards Aosta Valley, for the Ixs Downhill Cup, from 9 to 11 September, in Pila.

The Dt of the Italian national team of Downhill, Simone Fabbri, for the trip to Marianna has summoned ten athletes who, with good probability, will be protagonists on the 'du Bois' track in Pila in the Ixs stage, in practice the European Cup of the discipline. On all the two medalists of the European Championships in Maribor (Slovenia), in June: the bronze medal of the Alto Adige Veronika Widmann and the Junior silver medal of the Lecco-based Davide Cappello, both Italian Absolute champions in office, at the Sestiere, who repeated the title won in 2021, in Piazzatorre (Bergamo). Among the protagonists of the Aosta Valley stage there may also be Eleonora Farina from thirty, a great protagonist in the World Cup, with three third places conquered in Leogang (Austria), Lenzerheide (Switzerland) and Mont-Sainte-Anne (Canada).

To date, registrations have exceeded two hundred units, the final stage of the Ixs Downhill Cup that will be presented
